Keeps Pipes from Freezing

When the outdoor temperature is below 32° (32 is freezing):

1. **Open all doors to your pipes—kitchen, bathroom, and laundry room.**
2. **Keep both your hot and cold water dripping from all indoor faucets (kitchen, bathroom sink, bath room tub).**

When outdoor temperature is below 20° for a period of time:

1. **Open all doors to your pipes—kitchen, bathroom, and laundry room.**
2. **Keep a small stream of water running (from both hot and cold handles) from all in door faucets (kitchen, bathroom sink, bathroom tub).**

When outdoor temperature drops below 10° for even a night:

1. **Open all doors to your pipes—kitchen, bathroom, and laundry room.**
2. **Keep a small stream of water running (from both hot and cold handles) from all indoor faucets (kitchen, bathroom sink, bathroom tub).**

This is critical and very important!

Keep your furnace filters changed regularly so furnaces operate properly in very cold weather.
